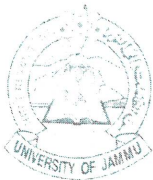

The draft syllabi for two Value-Added Courses titled ‘Environmental Education-I’ to be introduced during the 1st semester and ‘Environmental Education –II’ to be introduced during the 2nd semester was placed before the members. It was **RESOLVED** to confirm the UG syllabi of two Value-Added Courses as per the guidelines and curriculum framework for Environmental Education at the Undergraduate level for Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) as per NEP-2020 and recommend the same for the academic session 2025 and onwards (Annexure-III).

- Item – 5: To modify and review the syllabi of the Skill Enhancement Courses in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd semesters under FYUGP as per NEP-2020 from 2 credits to 3 credits from session 2025-2026 and onwards.**

BOS-ES authorizes the Convener, BOS-ES to prepare and send the panel of paper setter/examiners to Controller of Examinations as and when required.

- Item – 11: Sanction of Three Posts of Assistant Professors in the Centre for Distance & Online Education (CDOE), University of Jammu, to address the increasing workload**

The members were apprised that a significant number of students have been enrolled in Environmental Sciences (a compulsory subject) across various academic programmes offered by the Centre for Distance & Online Education (CDOE), University of Jammu. To facilitate the delivery of theory classes, conduct of practical sessions, and the evaluation process, CDOE has been requesting the Department of Environmental Sciences to provide

faculty support. However, due to the substantial workload within the department, it has become increasingly difficult to extend such support on regular basis.

Moreover, in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, a four- year Undergraduate programme has recently been approved by the Department of Higher Education and is likely to be implemented by CDOE in the near future. Considering the current challenges and the anticipated escalation in academic workload, and to maintain the quality of teaching and assessment, the Board of Studies (BoS) unanimously **RESOLVED** to recommend and forward the case for the sanction of three (03) posts of Assistant Professor in Environmental Sciences for the Centre for Distance & online Education (CDOE), University of Jammu.

Item – 12: Introduction of a mandatory 4-credit 'Environmental Education' course across all the Undergraduate programmes offered by some departments of the University, in alignment with the University Grants Commission (UGC) directives, the objectives of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, and the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's mandate. This initiative complies with the guidelines and curriculum framework for Environmental Studies/Sciences at the Undergraduate level for Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under NEP-2020 for the examinations to be held during the academic session 2025 and onwards.

Members unanimously **RESOLVED** to recommend the introduction of a mandatory 4 credit 'Environmental Education' course in all the Undergraduate programmes being offered by some departments in the University of Jammu, in alignment with the directions of University Grants Commission (UGC), the objectives of National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, and in compliance with the mandate of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under NEP-2020 for the examinations to be held during the academic session 2025 and onwards.

Item – 13: Eligibility criteria for admission to 'Environmental Sciences' as 'Major Subject' for Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP).

After thorough discussion, members unanimously **RESOLVED** that admission to 'Environmental Sciences' as 'Major Subject' shall only be given to the candidates having 'Sciences' at '10+2 level'.

The meeting terminated with a vote of thanks to the chair.
